Section 173 of the *Forest Act*

I, Larry Pedersen, Chief Forester, order that the allowable annual cut for Tree Farm Licence 25 is reduced by 135 000 cubic metres until the area referred to as the Central Coast Designated Area in B.C. Reg 115/2002 ceases to be a designated area.

This reduction is applied entirely to the allowable annual cut attributable to the partition to Block 5 of Tree Farm Licence 25. Within Block 5, the reduction is applied as follows:

- (a) the allowable annual cut attributable to stands in areas classified as operable only by helicopter is reduced by 37 000 cubic metres;
- (b) the allowable annual cut attributable to the portion of Block 5 other than the portion described in (a) is reduced by 98 000 cubic metres.

I, Larry Pedersen, Chief Forester, order that the allowable annual cut for the Mid Coast Timber Supply Area is reduced by 203 000 cubic metres until the area referred to as the Central Coast Designated Area in B.C. Reg 115/2002 ceases to be a designated area.

This reduction is applied as follows:

- (a) the allowable annual cut attributable to the partition in hemlock-balsam stands on sites of poor and low productivity is reduced by 20 000 cubic metres;
- (b) the allowable annual cut attributable to the portion of the timber supply area other than the partition is reduced by 183 000 cubic metres.

I, Larry Pedersen, Chief Forester, order that the allowable annual cut for the North Coast Timber Supply Area is reduced by 27 000 cubic metres until the area referred to as the Central Coast Designated Area in B.C. Reg 115/2002 ceases to be a designated area.

This reduction is applied as follows:

- (a) the allowable annual cut attributable to the partition in the portion of the timber supply area north of the Nass River remains unchanged;
- (b) the allowable annual cut attributable to the partition in the portion of the timber supply area which is considered highly visually sensitive remains unchanged;
- (c) the allowable annual cut attributable to the portion of the timber supply area other than the partitions referred to in (a) and (b) is reduced by 27 000 cubic metres.

I, Larry Pedersen, Chief Forester, order that the allowable annual cut for the Kingcome Timber Supply Area is reduced by 44 000 cubic metres until the area referred to as the Central Coast Designated Area in B.C. Reg 115/2002 ceases to be a designated area.

This reduction is applied as follows:

- (a) the allowable annual cut attributable to the partition in low productivity stands is reduced by 4000 cubic metres;
- (b) the allowable annual cut attributable to the partition in deciduous (broadleaf) forest stands is unchanged;
- (c) the allowable annual cut attributable to the portion of the timber supply area other than the partitions referred to in (a) and (b) is reduced by 40 000 cubic metres.
