

Chief Forester Order
Section 173 of the Forest Act

I, Ken Baker, Deputy Chief Forester, effective July 1, 2004, order that the allowable annual cut for Tree Farm Licence 46 is reduced by 9600 cubic metres, until the area referred to as the Hill 60 Designated Area in B.C. Reg. 95/2001 ceases to be a designated area.

This order cancels and replaces the Chief Forester Order signed by me on August 14, 2003, concerning the allowable annual cut reduction applied to Tree Farm Licence 46 resulting from the Hill 60 Designated Area. This change reflects recent clarification of the extent to which the designated area overlaps the tree farm licence area and the adjacent Arrowsmith Timber Supply Area.
