

## Chief Forester Order Section 173 of the Forest Act


I, Jim Snetsinger, Chief Forester, effective November 6, 2007, order that the allowable annual cut for the North Coast Timber Supply Area is reduced by 94,000 cubic metres, until the area referred to as the North Coast Designated Area No. 2 in B.C. Reg. 81/2006 ceases to be a designated area.

This order cancels the Chief Forester Order, signed by me, on September 28, 2006, concerning the allowable annual cut reduction applied to the North Coast Timber Supply Area resulting from the Central Coast Designated Area No. 2 in B.C. Reg 82/2006. This change reflects the status of those areas from the Central Coast Designated Area No. 2 in B.C. Reg 82/2006 which have received permanent designation as Conservancies under the *Protected Areas of British Columbia Act*.

This order cancels and replaces the Chief Forester Order, signed by me, on September 28, 2006, concerning the allowable annual cut reduction applied to the North Coast Timber Supply Area resulting from the North Coast Designated Area No. 2 in B.C. Reg 81/2006. This change reflects the status of those areas from the North Coast Designated Area No.2 in B.C. Reg 81/2006, which have received permanent designation as Conservancies under the *Protected Areas of British Columbia Act*.

This reduction is applied as follows:

- (a) the allowable annual cut attributable to the partition in the portion of the timber supply area north of the Nass River is reduced by 11,000 cubic metres;
- (b) the allowable annual cut attributable to the portion of the timber supply area other than the partition referred to in (a) is reduced by 83,000 cubic metres.
